The Navigator Subcompact is shipped with the manufacturer supplied components listed below:

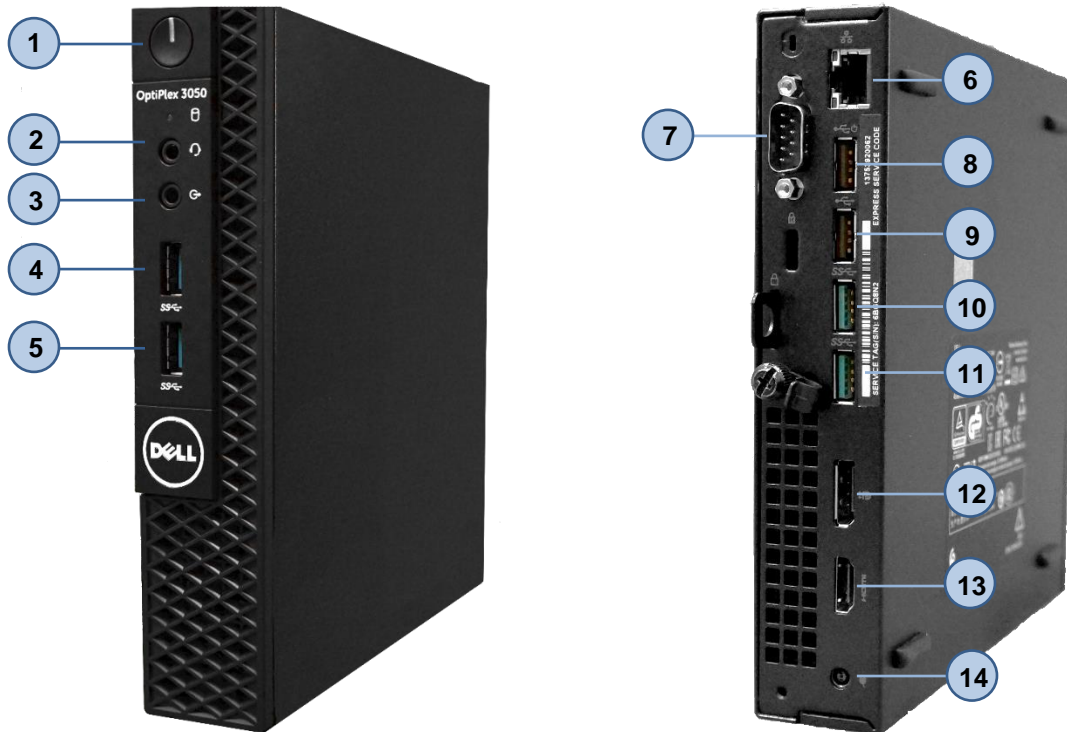

Installation

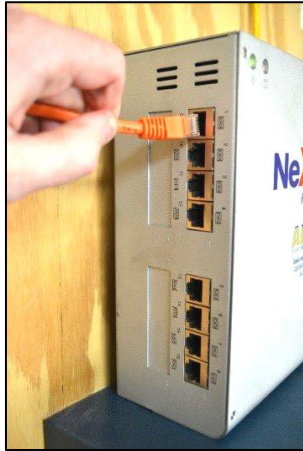
1. Insert Cat6 cable into 9-pin serial adaptor.



2. Connect serial adaptor to serial port.



3. Connect the other end of Cat6 cable to fuel controller (port number varies depending on your dispenser brand).



4. Connect Cat6 Ethernet cable (not supplied) to RJ-45 network port.



5. Connect the other end of Ethernet cable to network switch.



6. Connect power cable to power port, then connect other end of power cord to a power supply.



7. Connect VGA cable (not supplied) to VGA display adaptor.



8. Connect VGA adaptor to DisplayPort 1.2.



9. Connect mouse and keyboard to available USB ports.



10. Press power button to power on Navigator Subcompact Site Controller.
