- 3. Thermostat


#### **Additional Required Components**

- 2. Nuts and bolts
- 3. Washers
- 4. Adhesive tape

## **Hardware Identification**



- 1. Mounting hole
- 2. Power cord
- 3. Heater element
- 4. Thermostat
- 5. Mounting hole



**WARNING**: The heater element can get extremely hot. Avoid direct contact when the element is powered on. Damage may occur from direct contact with wires or other devices in the Sentinel.

## Installation

1. Measure two inches above interior Sentinel floor and mark each mounting hole.



2. Drill a hole through each pencil mark.



3. Use bolts and washers to attach heater element.




 Use adhesive tape to mount thermostat on cabinet wall opposite the heater element.
Place thermostat 6" – 12" higher than heater element.
